#### Regional Employment by Industry and Corresponding Employers







## Comprehensive Employment & Wage Data By Industry & Location

• Useful for understanding regional economic conditions & benchmarking against competitors.



## **Detailed Wage Data By Occupation & Geographic Area**

Prepare salary analysis, estimate budgeting, & target recruitment locations.



## **Annual Planning Process & Strategic Decision-making**

- Helpful in workforce planning, site location decisions, & expansion projections.
- Follow regular employment & earnings data by industry sectors.
- Track occupational growth projections, employment trends, wage inflation, industry movement.

#### **Bureau of Labor Statistics – Federal-State Cooperative Programs**

- Occupational Employment & Wages Statistics (OEWS) annual estimates of employment and wages for over 800 occupations in 22 major occupational groups based on a survey of business establishments covering wage and salary workers in nonfarm and nonmilitary establishments and does not include the self-employed, owners and partners in unincorporated firms, household workers, or unpaid family workers.
- Quarterly Census of Employment & Wages (QCEW) detailed employment & wages data reported by employers covering 95% of US jobs. Monthly & quarterly counts of workers covered by unemployment insurance programs. Provides total payroll & average wages paid. Categorized by industry and available for localities.

**U.S. Bureau of Economic Analysis (BEA)** – Official statistics of the economy, GDP, income, etc.

**O\*NET OnLine** – comprehensive resource for finding and learning about occupations.

FRED Federal Reserve Economic Data (St. Louis Fed) – Comprehensive resource
